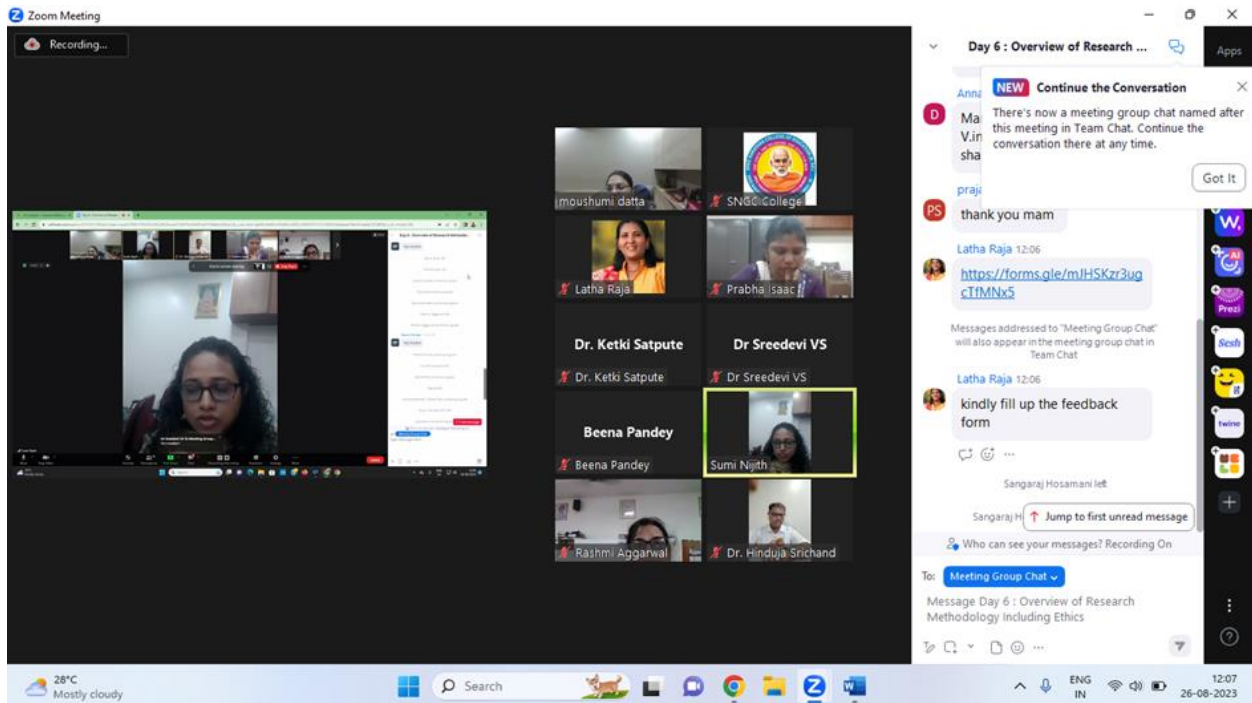
Day 6: Overview of Research Methodology including Ethics
